FAMILY FUN:

Walt Disney World Resort (\$\$\$)

Explore a portion of the magical Disney parks, enjoy thrilling rides, and meet your favorite Disney characters. Tickets vary depending on the park and date. Same-day ticket may be available. There is a kiosk at the front entrance of the hotel that can provide you more information and packages. We suggest organizing your Disney plans far in advance to accommodate your needs.

Universal Orlando Resort \$\$\$

Experience the excitement of Universal Studios and Islands of Adventure, featuring popular attractions like Harry Potter's Wizarding World. Ticket prices vary.

Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex \$\$

Discover NASA's space exploration history, see rockets up close, and even meet astronauts. Admission prices start at \$57 for adults. This is approximately 1 hour away from the event hotel.

Gatorland \$\$

Get up close with Florida's famous reptiles, including alligators and crocodiles, at this family-friendly wildlife park. Tickets start at \$29.99 for adults.

ICON Park \$\$

Enjoy dining, shopping, and entertainment at ICON Park, home to The Wheel, a giant observation wheel offering stunning views of Orlando. Costs vary depending on activities.

Boggy Creek Airboat Adventures \$\$

Experience the thrill of an airboat ride through the scenic Florida Everglades and spot wildlife like alligators and birds. Prices start around \$29.95.

The Morse Museum & Park Avenue \$

Explore the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art, featuring a vast collection of Tiffany glass, and then stroll along the charming Park Avenue in Winter Park. Admission is \$6.

Leu Gardens and Harry P. Leu Gardens \$

Visit Harry P. Leu Gardens, a 50-acre botanical oasis, and enjoy beautiful gardens and scenic landscapes. Admission is \$10 for adults.

Ripley's Believe It or Not! \$\$

Marvel at oddities and curiosities from around the world at Ripley's Orlando, a fun and quirky museum. Tickets start at \$19.99 for adults.

Orlando Science Center \$\$

Explore interactive exhibits, engage in hands-on learning, and enjoy live science demonstrations at the Orlando Science Center. Admission is \$21 for adults.

WATER PARKS:

Blizzard Beach \$\$\$

Enjoy a wintry wonderland at Disney's Blizzard Beach, featuring thrilling water slides and a unique alpine theme. Tickets start at approximately \$69 for adults.

Typhoon Lagoon \$\$\$

Dive into a tropical paradise at Disney's Typhoon Lagoon, known for its giant wave pool and water attractions. Prices begin at around \$69 for adults.

Volcano Bay \$\$\$

Immerse yourself in the South Pacific at Universal's Volcano Bay, offering water rides and a stunning volcano centerpiece. Tickets vary, starting at approximately \$80 for adults.

Aquatica Orlando \$\$

Experience the excitement of SeaWorld's Aquatica, featuring thrilling slides, lazy rivers, and encounters with marine life. Prices start at around \$49.99 for adults.

LEGOLAND Florida Water Park \$\$

Combine LEGO-themed attractions with water fun at LEGOLAND Florida Water Park. Tickets are usually included with LEGOLAND admission, starting at \$84.99.

Adventure Island \$\$

Enjoy a day of water adventures at Adventure Island, located near Tampa but accessible from Orlando. Tickets start at approximately \$44.99 for adults.

CoCo Key Water Park \$\$

CoCo Key Water Park offers a family-friendly experience with slides and pools. Day passes start at around \$26.99 for adults.

Discovery Cove \$\$\$

Explore an all-inclusive day of snorkeling with marine life and relaxing at Discovery Cove. Prices vary but can be around \$199 per person.

Nona Adventure Park \$\$

Nona Adventure Park features an inflatable water obstacle course and other fun water activities. Prices start at approximately \$20 per person.

Located in a picturesque lakeside setting, this museum focuses on American art, including the work of Earl Cunningham and contemporary artists.

Visit the historic Polasek residence and gardens while enjoying the sculpture collection of Albin Polasek.

The Wells'Built Museum of African American History and Culture \$

This museum showcases the history and contributions of African Americans in Central Florida.

Skeletons: Museum of Osteology \$\$

Discover a fascinating collection of real animal skeletons and learn about the science of osteology.


